Minutes of February 10th, 2026, REGULAR MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Troy Inman. Councilmembers present were McManus, McKie, Myatt and Elledge. Ted Wallace, Utilities Director, and Donald Reed, crewmember, were also present. Paul Fleming, from Edgin, Parkman, Fleming & Fleming accounting firm was in attendance to present the City's 2025 yearly financial audit. Val McClain, County Elections Administrator, attended to discuss contracting to consult for the City's election in May if the County Elections Administration office was eliminated. Other guests were asked to sign in.

Fleming summarized documents detailing the audit and answered several questions and scenarios and future possibilities from the mayor and councilmembers. Myatt made a motion to approve the audit as presented and McKie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Val McClain followed up on the request to her from Mayor Inman to possibly independently contract to consult and manage the City's general election in May if the County Elections Office was not going to contract elections anymore. She shared that she should know about the Elections Administration Office's plans after their meeting the next morning. Elledge made a motion that the subject be tabled until a Special City Council Meeting was called for February 17th, when more definite information was available for the council to discuss and take action for a plan. With a second from Myatt, the motion carried unanimously.

Public Participation brought no activity.

Expense of supplies, printing and machines to hold an election will be contingent on the administration who conducts the election. Myatt made a motion to pay the expenses incurred if needed by the City. Elledge seconded and all members were in favor. Motion carried.

Mayor Inman shared that there will be a bid opening meeting held at the City Hall on February 17th at 1:30 to receive bids and award the choice contractor to complete the Wastewater Treatment Plant Project.

Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed for approval. McManus made a motion to accept as presented with a second from McKie. All were in favor and the motion carried.

A resolution authorizing Linda McKie, mayor pro-tem, and Belinda Branigan, City Secretary in the case of Mayor Inman's absence, to execute documentation related to financial assistance from the T.W.D.B. and other matters in connection therewith. Elledge made a motion to adopt the resolution, McManus seconded and all members were in favor.

The monthly accounts payable were reviewed for questions and payment approval. McManus made a motion to approve and McKie seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.


Ted Wallace, Utilities Director, shared the monthly water & sewer report and answered questions from the mayor and councilmembers.
