CURFEW-MINORS

ORDINANCE NUMBER 614

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A CURFEW  
FOR MINORS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any minor person to be upon the streets of the City of Petrolia, Texas, after the hours of ten o'clock P. M. (10:00 P.M.) on SUNDAY through THURSDAY nights and on FRIDAY nights and SATURDAY nights after the hour of eleven thirty o'clock P. M. (11:30 P.M.)... unless such minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or is enroute to or from a place where such minor is employed, until the City Council deems it necessary to change this provision.

SECTION 2. That the curfew imposed in Section 1 above shall be lifted at five o'clock A.M. (5:00 A.M.) of each day.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.
