

ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF LIVE HOGS, SHOATS  
AND PIGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PETROLIA  
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
PETROLIA:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, from  
and after the 13th day of March, A. D., 1961 to keep or be con-  
cerned with keeping within the corporate limits of the City of  
Petrolia, any live hog, shoat or pig in any manner whatever.

Any person who shall violate any of the foregoing  
provisions shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction  
therefor shall be fined the sum of not less than Two Dollars  
(\$2.00) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each and every  
day that he shall keep or be concerned in keeping within the  
Corporate limits of the City of Petrolia in any manner any such  
hog, shoat or pig.
